In the wake of the Six-Day War of 1967, extensive territories came under Israeli control. The present volume represents the first attempt at a comprehensive and systematic treatment of the legal aspects relating to the Military Government in the Territories.

The editor, Supreme Court Justice Meir Shamgar, served as Military Advocate General from 1961 to 1968 and as Attorney General of Israel from 1968 to 1975. The book comprises articles by leading legal scholars in the field, and covers various topics of legal interest and importance as they relate to the administration of the Territories. Among the subjects discussed are: the applicability of the Fourth Geneva Convention, applicability of multilateral conventions, jurisdiction of the courts, standing of residents of the Territories in the Supreme Court of Israel, High Court review of the Military Government, choice of law, human rights safeguards, local government in Judaea and Samaria, and exploitation of natural resources in the Territories.

The appendices include English translations of the Supreme Court's decisions in the *Beth El Case*, the *Matityahu Case*, and the *Elon Moreh Case*, statistical tables, and English translations of relevant proclamations and orders.

The Table of Cases indexes decisions by the Supreme Court of Israel, the Israeli military courts, local courts in the territories, as well as English, United States, and other foreign cases cited. The book also includes maps of the Jordan-Israel Armistice line of 1949, the 1967 Cease Fire Lines, and the Golan Heights, as well as a general index.
