In addition, we have adopted the Harvard referencing system to bring us in line with what we see as the emerging standard for referencing in political science journals.

After 48 years of successful publication, *Government and Opposition* is looking forward to working with Cambridge for the continued success of the journal and for quality comparative politics scholarship.
