ROYAL PARK PSYCHIATRIC HOSPITAL

The Health Commission of Victoria is seeking a suitable person for this important senior position. Previous Psychiatrists Superintendents of Royal Park have been persons of high standing in Australian Psychiatry and included Dr. John Cade, discoverer of the therapeutic value of Lithium.

Royal Park Psychiatric Hospital provides in-patient, day-patient and out-patient services to the inner city area of Melbourne. Four Community Mental Health Clinics within the region provide out-patient services for patients of Royal Park in addition to community based services to specific areas. A wide range of psychiatric and other health facilities operate in the vicinity of the hospital.

The hospital is a major teaching unit for a range of disciplines. In addition to training Psychiatrists, General Practitioners and Medical Undergraduates, the hospital has a regional school of nursing and provides clinical placements for social work, occupational therapy and psychology students.

A full Chair in Psychological Medicine of Monash University will be established at Royal Park Hospital this year. This will be the first such Chair in a psychiatric hospital in Australia. In addition the University of Melbourne, Department of Psychiatry, is closely involved through the clinical schools at Royal Melbourne and St. Vincent's Hospitals.

The successful applicant will have the opportunity to participate in the extensive redevelopment of the hospital. A new psychogeriatric unit and clinical services block, incorporating comprehensive library and teaching areas, are to be built in the near future.

Opportunities for research will be available and the appointee will be closely involved in teaching and in liaising with University Departments and health facilities within the region. A close relationship between the appointee and Community Mental Health Centres is envisaged in the development of an integrated regional service.

**DUTIES:** To be responsible for the supervision and provision of clinical services in the Hospital and Community Mental Health Clinics in the region.

To perform the statutory duties of Psychiatrist Superintendent under the Mental Health Act.

To develop the hospital as a high quality treatment and teaching facility.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

To be a legally qualified medical practitioner registered or eligible for registration in the State of Victoria.

To be a Fellow or Member of the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Psychiatrists or to possess other qualifications recognised as equivalent.

To have had appropriate and adequate training and a wide experience in general psychiatry.

Possession of a higher degree and/or administrative qualifications would be an advantage.
