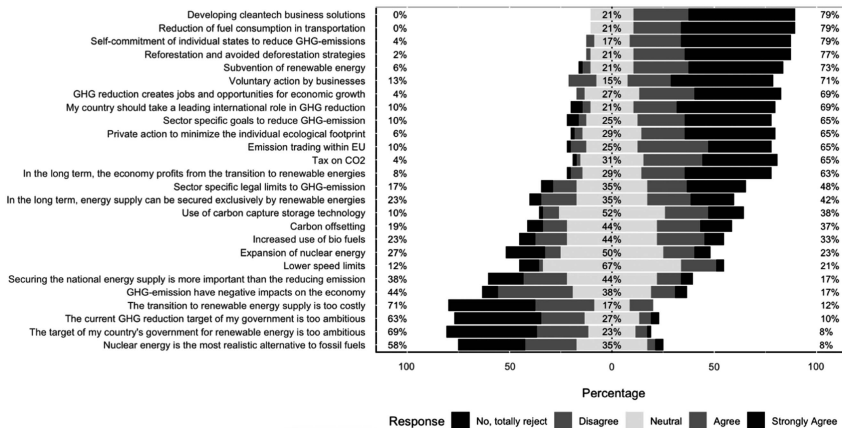


Figure 1. Respondents' opinions of 26 policy ideas. GHG = greenhouse gas.

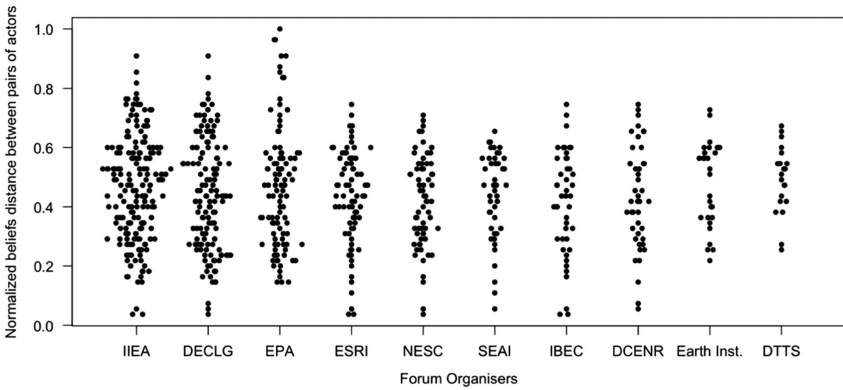


Figure 2. Normalized distance between the beliefs of each pair of actors that participated in the ten most attended forums.
