Authors Disney, Duffy, and Hardy wish to emend equations 9, 11, and 13 of "A Markov Chain Analysis of Pork Farm Size Distributions in the South," page 60 as follows:

$$(9) S_j^t = \sum_i (a_{ij} + b_{ij}HC^t) S_i^{t-1}$$

$$(11) S_j^t = (\sum_i a_{ij} S_i^{t-1}) + b_j HC^t$$

$$(13) S_j^t = (\sum_i a_{ij} S_i^{t-1}) + b_j HC^t$$
