

The Institution of Aeronautical Engineers.

At the Extraordinary Meeting held on July 23rd, 1925, the Objects and Rules were altered as follows —

11 *Annual Subscription*

There shall be an Annual Subscription graded and payable as under —

By Members with Honours Diploma, Members and Associate Members	Three Guineas
„ Associates	Two-and-a-half Guineas
„ Students	Ten Shillings and Sixpence.
„ Overseas Members with Honours Diploma, Overseas Members, Over- seas Associate Members, and Over- seas Associates	One-and-a-half Guineas
„ Overseas Students	Ten Shillings and Sixpence.

The Annual Subscription of Overseas Members, Associates and Students herein mentioned shall be retained by the Institution. Such Members, Associates and Students shall in addition pay such further subscription to their local branch as the Committee of such branch may fix. The Financial Year of the Institution shall run from January 1st to December 31st in each year. All subscriptions shall be payable in advance. Should any Member, Associate or Student fail to pay his Annual Subscription within twelve months from the date when the same became due the Council may accept such non-payment as a sign that the particular Member, Associate or Student has resigned from the Institution, and cause his name to be removed from the Register. Provided that the Secretary shall send to the last known address of such Member, Associate or Student at least fourteen days' notice of the intention of the Council before the preceding rule can take effect. Provided further that the Council may, at the request of such Member, Associate or Student, at any time reinstate his name upon such terms as shall seem to them just.

16a (a) *Constitution and Election of Council*

The Institution shall be governed by a Council to be elected at the Annual General Meeting consisting of one President, two Vice-Presidents, and not less than nine and not more than thirty Members, Associate Members and Associates. The number of Associate Members upon the Council shall not exceed one-third of the total membership of the Council. The number of Associates upon the Council shall not exceed two.

16 (b) The Members, Associate Members and Associates of Council other than the President and the Secretary shall be elected for three years, and

one-third of their number shall retire annually. The Secretary shall be appointed by the Council, and shall be entitled to a six-months' notice in event of the Council desiring to dispense with his services. A two-thirds majority of all members of the Council shall be necessary when dealing with any measures connected with the appointment of a permanent Secretary.

18 (a) *Voting*

The voting members of the Council are the President, the Vice-Presidents, the Members, Associate Members and Associates, and the Honorary Secretary.

The following Clauses were added to the Rules

18 (c) *Voting*

A meeting of the Members, Associate Members and Associates shall be convened by the Council once in every year for the purpose of receiving the Annual Report and for the election of Councillors. Upon receipt of a resolution signed by twenty Members and/or Associate Members and/or Associates requiring them to convene a General Meeting the Council shall proceed to convene same with all despatch. Fourteen days' clear notice shall be given of any Annual or Extraordinary Meeting.

18 (d) Upon all resolutions other than alteration of the Objects and Rules the votes of Members may be taken by post on a form supplied by the Council. In the case of voting by Overseas Members and the Australian Branch a cablegram for and on behalf of more than one Member shall be accepted as votes by the number of Members represented on the cablegram. Only such votes as are received by the Council prior to the hour of the meeting or on or before the date specified on the voting form shall be counted.
