The 2nd International Congress of Otology, Rhinology and Laryngology will be held in Madrid from 27th to 30th September 1932, under the presidency of Professor Tapia. The main subjects for discussion are Otosclerosis, Ozæna, and Scleroma, while subsidiary discussions on bronchoscopic and oesophagoscopic subjects and the treatment of malignant disease by penetrating radiations will take place.

To facilitate the preparation of the rapport on otosclerosis, the clinical aspect of which will be dealt with by Dr. Fraser of Edinburgh, a Committee of British otologists has drawn up a questionnaire, and it is hoped that all those to whom it has been sent will do their best to co-operate in filling in the desired particulars and returning the document as soon as possible.


