# How many political scientists can dance on the head of a pin?

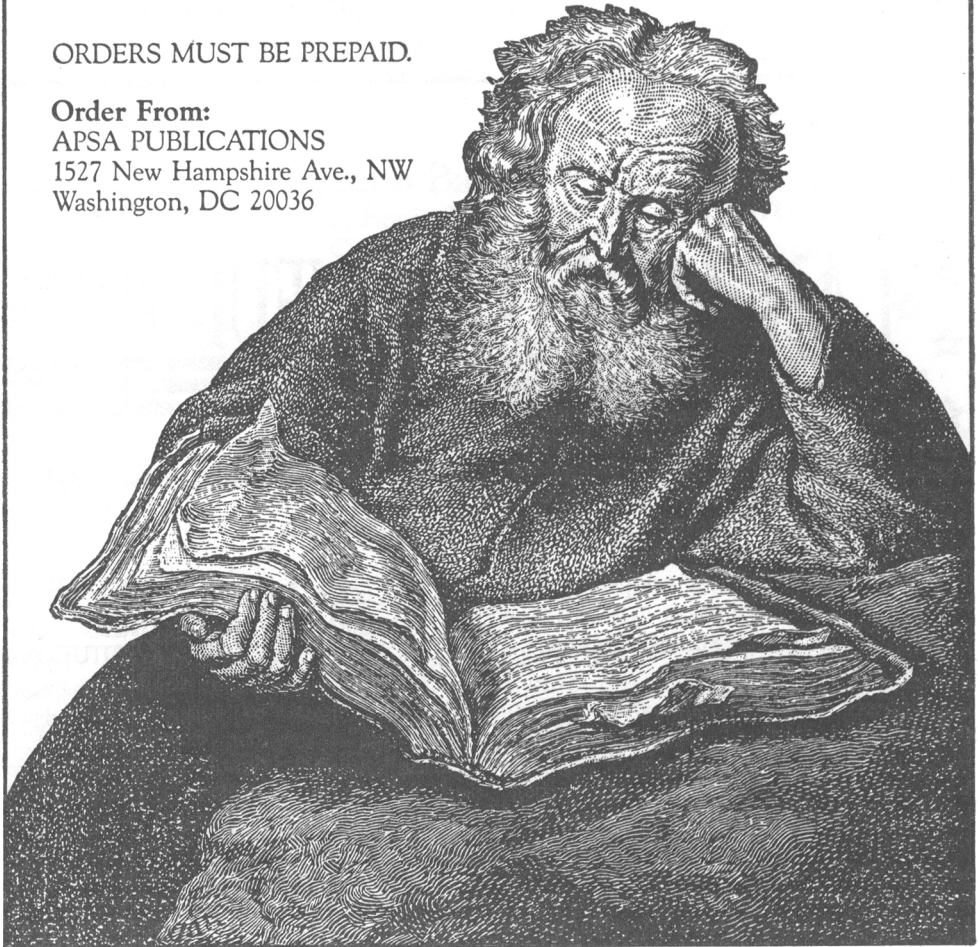
