Other well-known names in the roster are Hilda Graef, Dorothy Dohen, and Sister Julian Baird.

Each issue of Cross and Crown presents reviews of the newest spiritual books, both scientific and popular. A department called 'Current Trends' provides a compact survey of new developments in every aspect of the inner life.
