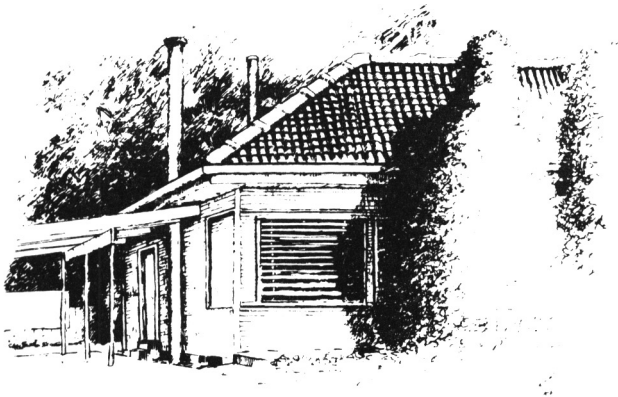
SHADE and SHELTER
