PROBLEM COUNTRY

It is difficult for us in this country to understand the problems facing South Africa today. It is too easy to judge by standards prevailing here without realising the tremendous difficulties encountered in the administration of vast areas, large populations and very differing traditions of outlook and culture. MISSIONARY IN SOUTH AFRICA is not a political book but it is written by a missionary who has lived and worked among the coloured population in S. Africa for over twenty years. What he has to say is said without prejudice but without attempting to minimise the problems involved. Originally written in 1953, when the present intensified policy of racial segregation was beginning, and giving a vivid picture of some of the consequences, both good and bad, this is a book that everyone engaged in, or setting out on, missionary work in S. Africa should read. But it is also a book which throws much light, for the ordinary reader, on the complexities of the situation - and incidentally on the difficulties and dangers facing missionaries everywhere, things that we at home are only too apt to forget.


