The 1975 International Clay Conference will be held in Mexico City, Mexico, on 16–23 July, 1975, sponsored by the Instituto de Geología, Universidad Nacional A. de Mexico and the Association International pour L'Etude des Argiles. Sessions are included on geology and diagenesis, crystal chemistry, geochemistry, colloidal properties, surface chemistry, analytical and interaction between clays and pollutants.
