

## EDITORS' NOTES AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

The undersigned Editors of these proceedings wish to thank all (well, most) of the authors who contributed to IAU Colloquium No. 138 for their promptness in submitting camera-ready material. Most of the poster papers were presented orally, which often led to discussions. These were recorded on sheets of paper handed out, and when these were returned to us, and they concerned points not explicitly set out in the printed text, we have typed them and included them together with the paper. The reviews and invited papers produced longer discussions. These will be found immediately following the last invited paper in each group; they are noted in the Table of Contents.
