In 1969 it was continued by the new Center of Asian Studies of the University of Hong Kong, and it now appears twice a year, in January and July, and includes articles in English and in Chinese on the arts and social sciences in East and Southeast Asia, and reviews of new scholarly publications on China and Southeast Asia.

The Journal is an indispensable adjunct to oriental studies and is taken by university libraries where there is academic work and interest in the Far East.
