Jennifer Walton's paintings capture the fragility of place in a rapidly changing global climate. Fire became a recurring theme in her work after her escape from a forest fire in North Ontario (Canada) while tree-planting in the late 1980s. *Conflagration* is part of a series of paintings entitled *Fire, Water, Ice and Snow*. In this series, she evokes mood and movement using layers of paint and the play of light and shadow.

Following her studies at Mount Allison University in Sackville, New Brunswick, Walton completed a Master of Fine Arts at Concordia University in Montreal. She was the first-place winner of the 1999 RBC Canadian Painting Competition. In 2007, she received an honorable mention from the Kingston Prize, Canada's National Portrait Competition. Her paintings have been exhibited widely across Canada and hang in numerous public and private collections throughout North America and the UK. Walton is represented by Abbozzo Gallery in Toronto.
