With the revolution in modern mathematics an established fact, and with a great deal of feedback from the Midlands Mathematical Experiment, it was learnt that the greatest area of dissatisfaction with existing texts lay in the middle and lower streams. It was therefore decided to adapt completely the existing MME course to these needs stressing the importance of practical as well as theoretical understanding and using language more easily comprehended by the lower ability student. *Maths Today* is, therefore, a mainstream course for secondary students in four volumes, written with public examinations in mind; the teacher should find most of the aspects common to all syllabuses.

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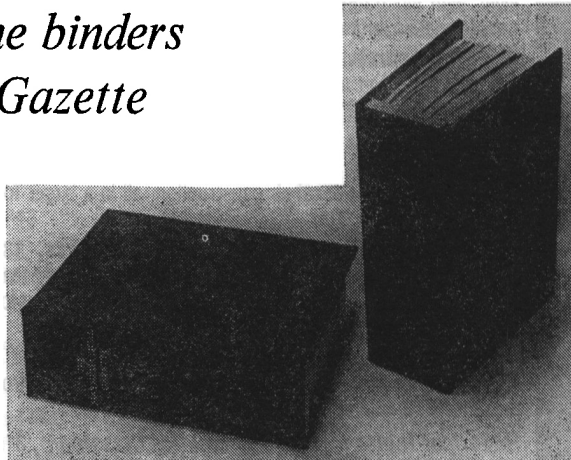
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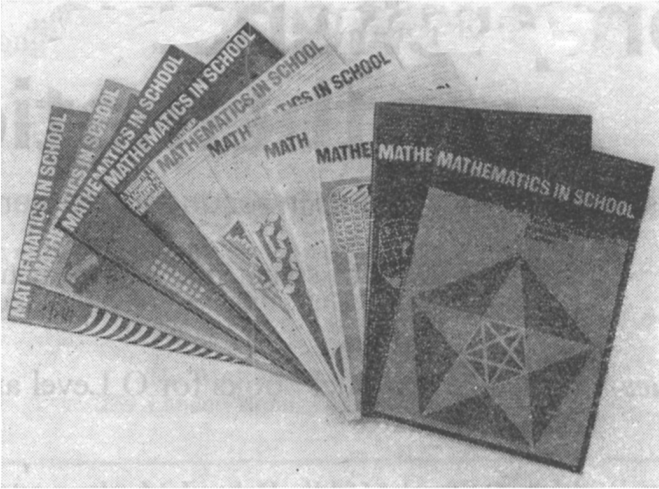
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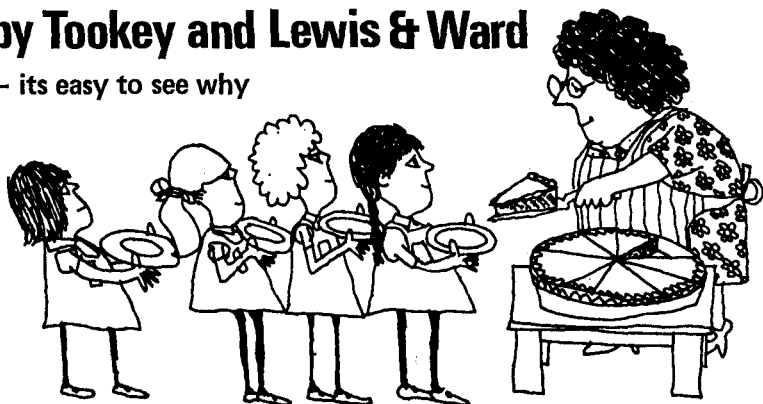
