2. References should be referred to in the text by giving, in brackets, the surname of the author and should be listed in numerical order at the end of the article, as follows:
Books: Author's name and initials; year of publication (in brackets); title of book underlined; publisher; page reference, if appropriate.
Articles: Author's name and initials; date of publication (in brackets); title of article; abbreviated title of journal underlined; volume and number.
3. Footnotes should be kept to a minimum.
4. Book reviews should be typed and sent to the Book Review Editor.
5. The editorial board do not hold themselves responsible for the views expressed by contributors.
