

Mobilise your nasal data



The GMI Acoustic Rhinometer Software has now moved completely onto the Windows operating system with the release of two new programs. The first is for rapid, principally graphical, assessment of each side of the nose followed by printout. The second allow a much more detailed examination and processing of the curves and the production of a detailed report. Movement between the acoustic software and its associated rhinomanometer can be effected very rapidly as, under Windows, both can be active simultaneously.

It is also possible to cut and paste any of the measurement or report screens directly into a word processor running on the same PC or to import the data directly into a statistical or database package, again running on the same PC. This will be particularly useful in the production of papers and in analysing groups of data.

All versions of WIndows from 3.1, including WIndows 95 are supported.
