### Brewer Prize Contest

The American Society of Church History announces a prize competition for a book-length manuscript in the field of church history. The award will consist of a grant of one thousand dollars to assist the author in the publication of the winning manuscript, which shall be described on its title page as the "Frank S. and Eliza D. Brewer Prize Essay of the American Society of Church History and shall be published in a manner acceptable to the Society." If competing essays are otherwise of equal quality, preference will be given to those dealing with topics related to the history of Congregationalism. Complete manuscripts in final form must be in the hands of the Secretary of the Society by June 1, 1953. Detailed information as to the form in which essays should be submitted may be secured from the Secretary, Professor Raymond W. Albright, 1524 Palm Street, Reading, Pennsylvania. The prize-winning essay will be announced at the Annual Meeting of the Society in December, 1953.
