Errata

Correction: In “Sexual Dimorphism in European Upper Paleolithic Cave Art,” by Dean R. Snow (*American Antiquity* 78:4, October 2013), three errors occur in the equations reported on page 751, as follows: (1) the appearance of a comma in place of a decimal point in the number 2.632; (2) the absence of a zero before the decimal point in the number 990.746; and (3) the absence of a zero before the decimal point in the number 1060.57.
