

'Archaeology in Greece' is an annual feature, and the periodic reports on work in other parts of the Greek world include Cyprus (this year), South Italy and Sicily (next issue), Central Italy and Eturia, the Black Sea, and other parts of the Mediterranean basin. In addition there are regular bulletins illustrating new acquisitions by Museums in Great Britain.

Because of the extra length of the report on work in Cyprus, which was postponed from last year as a result of the troubles on the island, both the section on acquisitions by the Cyprus museums and the bulletins from the Manchester and Bolton Museums have been held over until the next issue.
