"This work is a study of the spiritual life in its relation to the causal activity of divine love. Volume One treats of the nature of God's love, the first stage of the spiritual life and the laws of spiritual progress. Volume Two is concerned with the advanced stages of the spiritual life.

There is a series of chapters on Jesus Christ, the Mother of God and Saint Joseph as illustrative of the fullness of the life of grace. These chapters are rich in spiritual motivation and guidance that is a blend of dogmatic truth and practical direction. Two chapters of meditations, one on the way of the cross, the other on the mysteries of the rosary, are added as examples of devotion. An Epilogue concludes this work by insisting upon the uniformity of doctrine that exists in the works of St Thomas and St John of the Cross.

The reader will find the chapters on the cleansing effects of the theological virtues most informative and inspiring.
