Thoughts on the Passion Written for Children. By Rev. N. SCHNEIDERS, C.P. 569 pages. 37/6

Yet in this book Fr Schneiders covers all the catechism and all the bible history of the Passion and Death of Our Lord, and so clearly, accurately, and interestingly, that the child will not only understand it but will remember it.

The Life of Jesus Christ

In the Land of Israel and Among Its People. By Rev. F. M. WILLAM. Translated by Rev. N. Thomson. With a map of Palestine at the time of Christ. 500 pages. 37/6

Before setting pen to paper the author made in Palestine itself an intensive study of everything pertaining to the subject. In his work, therefore, he brings home vividly to the reader the importance of Jewish tradition and history; of racial and economic problems; of scenery, climate and topography—in a word, of every aspect which is of value in the elucidation of so many of Our Lord's sayings and acts.
