Journal of Laryngology and Otology (JLO) Travelling and Visiting Fellowships

The Directors of the *Journal of Laryngology and Otology* have founded two Fellowships. The first to be named the *Journal of Laryngology and Otology (JLO) Travelling Fellowship* is to enable a trainee in otolaryngology who has held the Fellowship of one of the Royal Colleges for at least two years and who holds a post recognised for Higher Surgical Training in the United Kingdom or the Republic of Ireland, to visit a centre or centres of excellence at home or abroad for up to two months in order to widen his or her knowledge in a particular field of the speciality. It is considered preferable that the applicants should be subscribers to the *JLO*.

The second fellowship to be named the *Journal of Laryngology and Otology (JLO) Visiting Fellowship* will be introduced in 1994/95 to enable a distinguished otolaryngologist from abroad to give one lecture in London and two further lectures by rotation in principle centres in the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland. The fellowships will be by invitation of the Editor and Directors of the *Journal of Laryngology and Otology* in consultation with the Presidents of the Sections of Otology and Laryngology and Rhinology of the Royal Society of Medicine.

Applications for the Travelling Fellowship are invited now.

Applications are invited for the first *Journal of Laryngology and Otology (JLO) Travelling Fellowship*.

Applicants must have been Fellows of one of the Royal Colleges of Surgeons for at least two years and hold an appointment as a Registrar or Senior Registrar recognised for Higher Surgical Training in the United Kingdom or the Republic of Ireland. They should preferably be subscribers to the *Journal of Laryngology and Otology*.

Applicants are asked to submit a current CV and write up to 1000 words describing where they wish to travel and which aspect of the speciality of otolaryngology they wish to study. It is anticipated that the Fellowship will enable the holder to travel for a period of up to two months. A report of the Fellowship will be published in the Journal. Please submit applications to:
