

THE FOURTH BIENNIAL CONFERENCE ON MEDIEVAL-RENAISSANCE STUDIES has been announced by New College of the University of South Florida for March 9-10, 1984, at the college in Sarasota. Papers are invited on all aspects of Europe and the Mediterranean between 1000-1600 A.D., with special emphasis on urban studies, courtly culture, and drama. The deadline for submission of one-page abstracts is December 1, 1983. The conference will also feature a national undergraduate student paper contest with cash prizes; the winner need not be in attendance.
