Research is important in all areas of emergency medicine. As such, physicians and fellows working in diverse academic, non-academic, community, and rural settings are encouraged to electronically submit Research Grant applications.

Grants are submitted electronically starting **Tuesday, September 18, 2013 at 09:00 EST.**
The deadline for submission is **Friday, November 1, 2013, 23:59 MST.**

PRE-REQUISITE FOR SUBMITTING PROPOSALS

- The Principal Investigator (PI) and Supervisor (for Residents and Fellows only) must be current CAEP members at the time of application
- The PI must be < 8 years beyond postgraduate training
- A letter from Resident's/Fellow's Supervisor must be included with the proposal

APPLICATION PROCESS

Grants are submitted electronically at <http://caep2014researchcompetitions.abstractcentral.com>

Proposals must be single-spaced text (excluding references and appendices) using size 12 font.
Submissions will include:

- Structured Research Abstract
- Research In Depth
- Timeline and Impact
- References
- Research Data Collection Tool
- Detailed Budget and Justification
- Curriculum Vitae of the Principal Investigator ONLY
- Accompanying Letter from the Responsible Supervisor

A Cover Letter is not required.

GRANT REVIEW PROCESS

Grants are peer reviewed by 3 CAEP Grant Reviewers using a standardized evaluation form. Reviewers are blinded to the author's name and institutional affiliations. Reviewers will not review grants from their own province and strict conflict of interest declarations are provided to each reviewer. Reviewers consider:

- Relevancy to emergency medicine
- Methodological quality
- Originality of the topic and methodology
- Level of training
- Ability to complete the proposed study

Notification of acceptance will be transmitted via email no later than January 31, 2014.

FUNDING PROVISIONS

Funding support to an individual project will not exceed \$5000. Funding cannot be a supplement to other funding sources and shall not be used for meeting registration, travel or equipment purchases.
