The Life of Our Lord Jesus Christ in Meditations

By Maurice Meschler, S. J.

This two-volume life of Christ in meditations is a series of spiritual reflections based directly on the events and discourses in the life of our Saviour. In each instance the author begins with the Gospel narrative, which is followed by an account of the historical and other circumstances. Then follow the devout reflections. The deeds and words of our Lord are an inexhaustible source of doctrinal and moral teaching, and from this treasure Father Meschler has drawn a wealth of spiritual interpretation and application.

For the convenience of preachers an appendix has been added to provide quick reference to the commentary on each Sunday's Gospel. An alphabetical index serves the same purpose in different form.
