Dr Shaban studies the social and political causes and effects of the 'Abbasid Revolution of the eighth century A.D. Using new source material, he describes the situation in eastern Iran at the time of the Arab conquest, the relationship of the Arab settlers with the conquered people and the central government, and their internal rivalries. A discussion of the revolution itself considers the ideological content and how far it was successful in achieving its objectives.

Dr Shaban challenges the commonly held view that the Revolution was precipitated by the failure of Arab rulers to treat their Iranian subjects as equals. \$14.50
