Preservation of psychiatric records

From time to time, members of the College become concerned at the proposal to dispose of patients' records owing to their bulk, the cost of storage, etc. This note is to bring to members notice the recent Department of Health circular HC/89/20 detailing responsibilities of health authorities under the Public Records Act. Appendix C of this circular lays down minimum retention periods for records which are not for permanent preservation and in some cases a period as short as eight years is laid down. However (Paragraph 16), it is noted that special considerations apply to records of mentally disordered people, and the period of 20 years from the date at which in the doctor's opinion the disorder has ceased (and Paragraph 13), as long as the person of "unsound mind" remains under disability, is also mentioned.

Members may be more concerned as to the preservation of records for research purposes, but if destruction of records is suggested, it may be helpful to them to draw local managers' attention to the details of the Department of Health recommendations.
