Secondly, the *Journal* opens its pages to occasional papers summarising and reflecting on some aspect of theoretical linguistics. These contributions will be commissioned, though offers can be submitted for editorial consideration of their theme, scope and accessibility with regard to the *Journal's* editorial policy. If approved for further consideration, these and special issue papers will be subject to the *Journal's* standard refereeing procedure. Further information will be found in *JL's* Instructions for Contributors.

We also inform our readers that Cambridge University Press has moved the processing of *JL* manuscripts to the ScholarOne/Manuscript Central system. This means that submissions, refereeing and editorial decisions are now done online.
