NORTHUMBERLAND AND DURHAM

On Saturday, January 15th, a number of members and intending members of the British Institute of Philosophical Studies met, by kind permission of Sir Theodore Morison, in the Council Room, Armstrong College, Newcastle-upon-Tyne. Professor F. B. Jevons of Durham presided, and letters of regret for absence were received from Dr. Messer, the Rev. E. Thomas, and Mr. R. J. Wilson, M.P. Those present, in addition to the Chairman, were Mrs. Common, Miss M. K. Heslop, Miss M. Morton, Miss V. Stevenson, Mrs. J. E. Alderson, Messrs. D. F. Beaumont, Common, A. C. Ewing, E. Hinton, J. McNeill, Gilbert Richardson, R. Robertson, L. Roddam, and S. Tomkeieff. It was decided to form a northern centre of the Institute for Northumberland and Durham members. Professor F. B. Jevons was unanimously elected Chairman of the new Centre, and Mrs. J. E. Alderson, Armstrong College, was appointed Secretary.

The first meeting of the group took place in Armstrong College on Wednesday, February 2nd, at 5 p.m., when a discussion on Spinoza was introduced by Mr. S. Tomkeieff. A second meeting has been arranged for Wednesday, March 2nd, when the relation of philosophy to science will be discussed.
