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Band Rotunda and Fountain, Queen's Park, Maryborough 1930. This hand coloured postcard shows the glorious Melville Fountain purchased from the Glasgow International Exhibition of 1888, in memory of Andrew Wedderburn Melville, donated by his sister Miss Janet Melville. The Fountain was opened in 1890 with the protective rotunda above it. Early in the 1900s, the Rotunda was repositioned as a separate structure on a concrete plinth enabling bands to perform sheltered from the sun.
