The Squadron, formed at the R N Air Station at Gosport (Hants), sailed for the Far East in the ferry carrier "Perseus," within a few weeks The Navy's first operational helicopter unit, it has also transported nearly 200,000 lb of freight over the Malayan jungles In addition, helicopters have lowered tracker dogs used to round up terrorists, dropped leaflets and carried out valuable low reconnaissance work over clearings They have spent more than 3,500 hours in the air
