# Editorial

The flavour of this issue of *ReCALL* is decidedly international, with contributions from Australia, the United States, the Netherlands, Hong Kong and Northern Ireland. This wider perspective is the result of the close formal link between the CTI Centre for Modern Languages and the EUROCALL organisation. The EUROCALL 94 conference, held at the Pädagogische Hochschule, Karlsruhe, features prominently, with the previous conference hosts at the University of Hull continuing the reporting tradition set by colleagues in Helsinki. The abstracts of papers from EUROCALL 94 give an idea of the range and diversity of material presented.

From the next issue, in May 1995, *ReCALL* will have an international Editorial Board in place and a newly-designed cover. An independent panel of referees has also been appointed, reflecting the whole spectrum of research, development and teaching interests represented by readers of *ReCALL*. This rigorous refereeing process is designed to ensure that the highest academic standards are maintained. Without doubt, the character of *ReCALL* will change over the coming years to reflect the wider EUROCALL constitution, which includes UK and overseas institutions, and the secondary and FE sectors as well as commercial organisations. We hope the contents of *ReCALL* will continue to stimulate research, development and practice in the field of technology enhanced language learning, and we particularly welcome comments and material from new contributors.
