The JOURNAL is the official organ of the Association for Symbolic Logic, an international organization for furthering research in symbolic logic and exchange of ideas among mathematicians, philosophers, and others interested in this field.

Individual membership in the Association is open to anyone interested in its work. Annual dues for members are \$40, or \$20 for students. Dues include subscription to the current volume of the JOURNAL. For their personal use, members may purchase back volumes at a discount. Persons wishing to subscribe to the JOURNAL for their individual use without becoming Association members should write to the Secretary-Treasurer.

Institutional membership in the Association is available to any academic institution or department. Annual dues are \$275. Membership privileges include choices of current subscriptions, of back volumes, and of student memberships; a detailed description is available from the Association. Information on corporate membership is also available from the Association.

Back volumes of the JOURNAL are available. Prices per volume in paper form are as follows: \$46 for Volumes 1–13, \$92 for Volumes 14–30, \$110 for Volumes 31–45, \$124 for Volumes 46–47, \$180 for Volumes 48–49, \$160 for Volumes 50–52, and \$180 for Volumes 53–54. Volume 26 is an index for Volumes 1–26; Number 4 of Volume 45 is an index for Volumes 27–45. The two indexes may be purchased together for \$120. Members of the Association may purchase back volumes for their personal use at a 25% discount. A Bibliography of Symbolic Logic by Alonzo Church (from Volumes 1 and 3) may be purchased separately; the price is \$18 for members or \$24 for nonmembers.
