

Editor's Note

Baker Library of the Graduate School of Business Administration, Harvard University, announces pre-doctoral and post-doctoral fellowships in business and economic history. The grants are for maintenance during December, 1971, through February, 1972, and it is expected that most of the fellows will be working on doctoral dissertations. However, applications are welcome from others who are free at some point during this period. Fellows will be provided with a room and \$10 per day for up to a month's time. Access to other Harvard libraries will be provided. In awarding the grants, major consideration will be given to the importance of the Library's resources to the candidate's work.

The awards will be announced no later than November 15.
