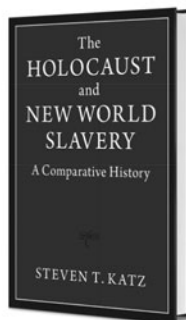

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR CONTRIBUTORS

*AJS Review* publishes scholarly articles and book reviews covering the field of Jewish studies. From biblical and rabbinic textual and historical studies to modern history, social sciences, the arts, and literature, the journal welcomes articles of interest to both academic and lay audiences around the world. A substantial portion of each volume is devoted to reviews of the latest Judaic scholarship and review essays on current trends in the field.

### MANUSCRIPT SUBMISSION

Manuscripts for consideration should be submitted through the *AJS Review* online submission system, which can be found at: <https://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/AJSReview>. For any questions please contact the managing editor at [review@associationforjewishstudies.org](mailto:review@associationforjewishstudies.org).

The main body of articles cannot exceed 10,000 words in length, not counting notes, tables, and charts. Notes, tables, and charts should not exceed an additional 5,000 words, except in unusual cases. If the article has a lengthy appendix, please consult with the editors in advance of submission. Articles should conform to *Chicago Manual of Style*, 17th edition.

Hebrew articles should also conform to *Chicago Manual of Style*, ed. 17 in all respects, including citation style. Hebrew articles are subject to the same word limits as articles in English.

### COPYRIGHT

Submission of an article is taken to imply that it has not been previously published and is not being considered for publication elsewhere. Authors must obtain written permission for material for which they do not own the copyright. A Copyright Transfer Agreement, with certain specified rights reserved by the author, must be signed and returned to the Editors by senior authors of accepted manuscripts, prior to publication. This is necessary for the protection of both author and the Association under copyright law.
