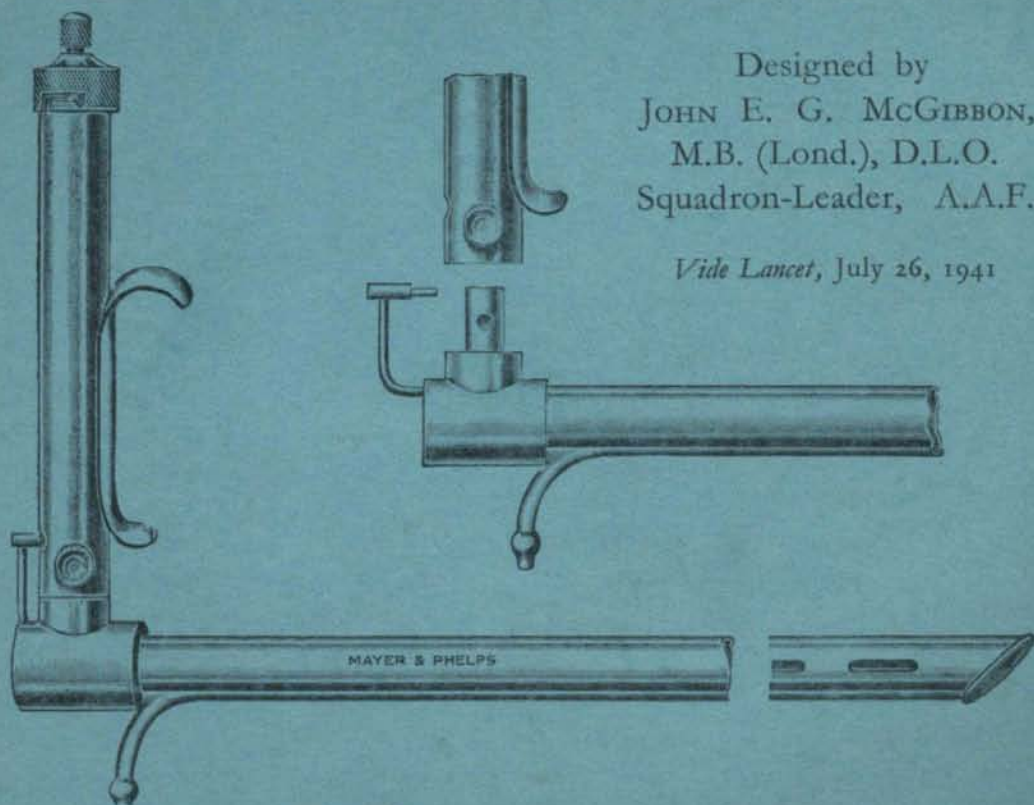


AN EMERGENCY BRONCHOSCOPE

- A Bronchoscope self contained with battery in handle, dispensing with entangling cables.
- The Bronchoscope was designed for Bronchial aspiration and insufflation of oxygen in cases of emergency.
- The handle is provided with a finger rest to facilitate introduction, and is detachable for sterilization.
- Oesophagoscopes and Bronchoscopes can be made of various lengths and calibres as desired (*see page 73, Catalogue of Laryngology*). That illustrated above is 40 cm. \times 10 mm.
