Professor Chester has written the first complete history of the role of radio and television in American politics—from 1920, when KDKA announced Harding's victory, through the campaigns and elections of 1968.

The sweeping changes that radio and TV have effected in American political processes at both the local and national levels are here chronicled—and analyzed—in full and immensely revealing detail. The landmarks of radio-TV impact—FDR's "Fireside Chats," Nixon's "Checkers" speech and the Nixon-Kennedy debates, among many others—are seen in fresh perspective. The body of laws, regulations and "doctrines" that has evolved to deal with radio and TV problems affecting political life is thoroughly covered, as are current questions of censorship. In fact, every aspect of radio-TV influence on politics is dealt with.

Professor Chester has gathered all the available data, including unpublished material from the several presidential libraries. His Notes on Sources following each chapter and a selected bibliography of some 500 items help to make his book a seminal work of vital interest to everyone concerned with the political scene yesterday, today . . . and tomorrow. \$7.50
