Theoretical or empirical research that advances the discourse of Catholic Social Thought.

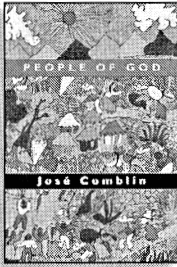
Analysis of existing documents in Catholic Social Thought that is particularly relevant to the issue.

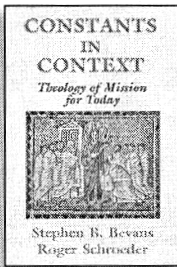

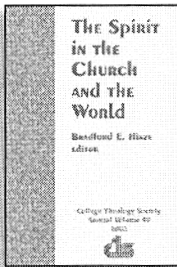

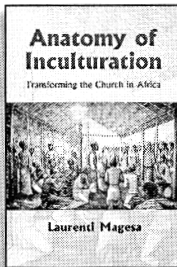
