✎ “Witness to the Holocaust: An Oral History Project” was begun at Emory University in the summer of 1978 under the auspices of the Center for Research in Social Change and the Jay and Leslie Cohen Chair of Judaic Studies. The project will study the Holocaust through the eyes of those people who were involved in liberating the POW, labor, and death camps (military personnel, press, relief agency workers, etc.). The liberators’ memories and observations will be obtained through in-depth interviews, and their recollections, pictures, diaries, and memorabilia will be made available for scholarly analysis.
