

MLA Selective List of Materials

for use by teachers of modern foreign languages in
elementary and secondary schools

The *List*, prepared under contract with the U. S. Office of Education in 1961-62, supersedes the *MLA Materials List* published in 1959.

The list contains evaluations of 1800 items (textbooks, discs, tapes, maps, bibliographies, films, filmstrips, slides, periodicals, readers, dictionaries).

Ten foreign languages are treated: French, German, Italian, Modern Hebrew, Norwegian, Polish, Portuguese, Russian, Spanish, Swedish.

Ten committees of evaluators, 184 experienced school and college teachers, rated 2400 items according to carefully worked out criteria (published as an Appendix in this edition) and added descriptive paragraphs for the 1800 items judged excellent or acceptable.

Full bibliographical details are given for each item.

Appendices, in addition to the criteria, include annotated lists of cultural readings for teachers and a list of 684 sources of materials (publishers, producers, distributors, importers).
