They are also offered for sale to the public (obtainable from The Editor (Reports), Hellenic Society, 31-34 Gordon Square, W.C.1) at the price of 12/6, postage paid. 'Archaeology in Greece' is an annual feature, and the occasional reports on work in other parts of the Greek world include Cyprus (this year), South Italy and Sicily, Asia Minor, the Black Sea, etc. In addition there are regular bulletins illustrating new acquisitions by museums in Great Britain.

The picture on the cover is of a pebble mosaic, of the later fourth century B.C., from Rhodes. See p. 38.

This year's 'Archaeology in Greece' is of greater length than has been usual in the past and reports more fully on British excavations as well as giving condensed coverage to the many Greek publications that have appeared during the last twelve months. In view of this increase in size, the report on The Greek Museum, The University, Newcastle upon Tyne, has been postponed until 1970.
